<b>Recommendation</b>	<b>Comments from Stanshawes Care Home</b>
<p>1. Ensure that mealtimes are more sociable and stimulating occasions by ensuring members of staff talk with residents when assisting them with meals, and/or considering how to find volunteers to support a social atmosphere during mealtimes.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Home has protected meal times in place.</li> <li>• Home will continue to make sure staff continue to stimulate residents during meal times.</li> <li>• Home has recruited volunteers and will continue to recruit more (contacted Age UK and Dementia Awareness group.)</li> </ul>
<p>2. Ensure subtitles are available on the television for residents who are hard of hearing.</p>	<p>Subtitles can be arranged on the television for the residents in the home, but it depends on each individual's make and model of television (if it's their own.)</p>
<p>3. Consider how RNIB Reading Choices could be made available for residents with visual impairments.</p>	<p>Home do not have registered blind resident, but the other choices are already available (magnifiers, large prints etc.)</p>
<p>4. Consult with residents and introduce some exercise activities to promote fitness and wellbeing.</p>	<p>Chair exercises is there in the activity planner (weekly).</p>
<p>5. Personalise residents' bedroom doors and add items of interest to corridor walls to stimulate residents.</p>	<p>Home is in the process of buying new pictures for the corridor walls.</p>

<p>6. Review the decision to not create memory boxes. This should be done with the involvement of both residents and their relatives.</p>	<p>Residents do have reminiscence sessions as part of their activities (it is in the weekly activity planner too.)</p>
<p>7. Continue to make links with the local community and seek volunteers to support activities and mealtimes.</p>	<p>Please see 1.</p>
<p>8. Consider the introduction of apprenticeships, work experience and volunteering from local schools and colleges to bring young people into the home.</p>	<p>Home is already liaising with local school, local college for work experience.</p>
